TRAFFIC ORDER PROPOSALS – 30MPH SPEED LIMIT IN LONGMOOR ROAD AT LIPHOOK

Hampshire County Council proposes making a traffic order as follows:

EFFECT OF ORDER: will be to impose a 30mph speed limit (existing 40mph) on that length of C48 Longmoor Road between a point 50 metres west of its junction with The Avenue and a point 763 metres west of that point.

The order will revoke and re-enact the provisions contained in two existing orders with no change of substance save for minor amendments to descriptions and the proposed speed limit as described above.

Persons wishing to make objections or other representations are advised that in the order-making process, objections or other representations may become publicly available and therefore the names and addresses of those persons making objections or other representations may also be made publicly available.

TITLE: The order, if made, will be known as The Hampshire (Various Roads, Liphook) (Restricted Road and 20, 30, 40 and 50 Miles per Hour Speed Limit) Order 2017.”
