#### **“Public Consultation Event - Bohunt Manor Liphook”**

A public event is being held in Liphook to give the local community an opportunity to discuss their thoughts on the future of land at Bohunt Manor in Liphook.

The event will take place at the Liphook Millennium Hall, 2 Ontario Way Liphook, on Tuesday 27 November 2007 from 5pm. In attendance will be Nash Partnership, the agents acting for the landowner Geriwell Management SA, East Hampshire District Council, and local councillors.

The development team is keen to obtain feedback and views on the potential development proposals for the frontage land at Bohunt Manor. Local Councillors want to hear what the community thinks about using the land for sporting and recreational purposes. East Hampshire District Council will be on hand to provide advice on the planning aspects of any development ideas, and to give a short presentation on the Local Development Framework, to inform people about the planning process.

“This is the first stage of any community involvement in a possible development of the site and a key event” said Councillor Anna James, Chairman of the Parish Council Planning Committee. “Under the new planning process it is really important for us to participate and help determine how the site will be used in the future” she added.

The event will begin with an informal, exhibition about the site proposals. Mr Chris Beaver, representing Nash Partnership and his colleagues will be available to talk to members of the community on an informal basis and listen to their views and opinions about the site, and their future aspirations for Liphook. Councillors representing East Hampshire District Council and Bramshott & Liphook Parish Council will be present to hear the local views about sport and recreational facilities on the site. At 7.30-pm there will be a short presentation on the Liphook Development Framework given by Mr Alistair Spiers the Senior Policy Planner at East Hampshire District Council. The event will conclude with a Question and Answer session for anyone interested in the proposals. Refreshments will be available.
