The next showing at the Liphook Millennium Centre Cinema in Liphook will be “The History Boys” on Friday 21 September at 8.00pm.

A class of gifted teenage boys charm and wisecrack their way through the summer of 1983 as two very different teachers steer them towards their Oxbridge exams. The big screen version of Alan Bennett's stage play is a brilliant, beguiling and extraordinarily entertaining British comedy. In the mid 1980's in a grey and grim northern Grammar school, a select number of very bright boys are desperately trying to pass the Oxbridge entrance exams. What evolves is a story that effortlessly illustrates the bravado, humour and vulnerability of teenagers as they navigate their way to adulthood. The film stars Richard Griffiths and Frances de la Tour supported by Samuel Anderson, James Corden, and Stephan Cambell Moore.

Doors open at 7.30pm and the performance starts at 8.00 pm. Tickets are priced at £4 with a concession of £3.00 for OAP (60 and over).
