“Julie & Julia”

The next showing at the Liphook Millennium Centre Cinema in Liphook will be “Julie & Julia” on Friday 9 April 2010.

Julie & Julia melds the analogous stories of cooking legend Julia Child's life in 1950s France with the modern-day tale of writer Julie Powell's real-life quest to prepare all 524 recipes in Child's classic tome “Mastering the Art of French Cooking”. This entertaining and amusing film stars Amy Adams as Julie and Meryl Streep as Julia. The film neatly covers Child's life in post-World War II Paris with her foreign diplomat husband Paul, her foray into and eventual mastery of French cooking, and the difficulties she encountered while trying to publish her groundbreaking cookbook. Intercut with Child's story is Powell's decision to shake up her life as an unfulfilled government employee in post-9/11 New York by challenging herself to cook and blog. Her inevitable trials and victories are all included.

Doors open at 7.30pm and the performance starts at 8.00pm. Tickets are priced at £5, with a concession of £4 for OAPs (60 and over).
