Public consultation on traffic calming proposals on Longmoor Road, Liphook

Planning permission was granted in December 2012 for the development of 155 new homes at Lowsley Farm to the north-west of Liphook village.

As part of this consented scheme, traffic calming measures are proposed along Longmoor Road on the western edge of the village where there will be a new roundabout to access the new homes.

This letter is further notice of the ongoing proposals to this area, as you will be aware that on 14 April 2015 a public consultation event was held to allow residents living close to this section of Longmoor Road to comment on these proposed traffic calming measures. Following residents' feedback we will now be holding another event to allow those who may not have been able to attend previously to have their say.
