OSU SITE. The application by EHDC for two office blocks and three light industrial units was granted planning permission on September 8. Building contractors are now being appointed and it is anticipated work will start on site in January and take a year to build out. There has been considerable interest from prospective tenants for all parts of the development. The rental income received from the development will be re-invested in local economic development projects and contribute to the Council's strategy to be financially independent.

TAG FARNBOROUGH. Together with East Hampshire MP Damian Hinds, EHDC has been pro-active in investigating the impact of a proposal to increase flights by private jets into Farnborough. The proposals will see more aircraft at lower altitudes over Liphook, Liss, Grayshott and nearby villages and impact on glider activity at Lasham. It is understood that Liss Parish Council has already objected. EHDC debated this issue at its meeting on Thursday (Sept 22) and resolved to seek more information from TAG and the Civil Aviation Authority before making an official representation. Mr Hinds and EHDC leader Cllr Ferris Cowper are seeking a meeting with the head of the CAA.

NEIGHBOURHOOD PLANNING BILL. EHDC is fully supportive of the Bramshott and Liphook Neighbourhood Plan and as head of the lead planning authority, chief planning officer Simon Jenkins has offered to attend meetings and give advice. The Government has just released a new Neighbourhood Planning Bill which is being scrutinised by the Planning team. It is anticipated that with the change in Prime Minister and changes within all departments in Government, there will be further new documentation issued, and more enactments of the earlier Housing and Planning Act, over the coming months.
