### **MINUTES**

**Present:** Dr J Tough (Chairman), Mr S Coyte, Mr L Fatcher, Mr A Jordan, Mr D Murray (Parish Councillors), and one member of the press were also present.

The Chairman announced that the Parish Transport Representatives meeting will be held on 19 November, the Portsmouth Rail Users Meeting is now being held on 13 December and the CPRE Transport Symposium is on 24 November.

#### **44/05 APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE**

#### **45/05 MINUTES OF MEETING OF 3 OCTOBER 2005**

Minutes agreed and signed as being a true record.

#### **46/05 MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES**

##### 11/05 Station access and platform extension

The Chairman confirmed that a meeting to discuss disabled access to the station and the platform extension is being arranged.

##### 28/05 Proposed bridleway at Passfield

The Chairman confirmed that the meeting planned for 4 November had been deferred and would be rearranged.

##### 38/05 Midhurst Road extension of double yellow lines

Asst Clerk confirmed that amended proposal includes limited waiting area for approximately two vehicles.

#### **47/05 DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST**

The Chairman read out the declaration.

#### **48/05 UPDATE ON SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL – JUNIOR & INFANT SCHOOLS**

The Chairman confirmed that a meeting with the schools was planned for 17 November.

#### **49/05 UPDATE ON TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT PROJECTS**

##### Headley Road/Portsmouth Road

Asst Clerk confirmed that the proposed zebra crossing in Headley Road and cyclerooute in Portsmouth Road are due to be installed around Christmas. Traffic calming requested for these areas will be reviewed once these works are completed.

##### The Square

Asst Clerk informed members that she was continuing to press for removal of the blockwork crossing in The Square as this causes confusion for pedestrians and motorists due to the proximity of the zebra crossing. Cllr Coyte said the blockwork crossings in Haslemere Road still indicated the safest place to cross.

##### The Avenue

Cllr Coyte proposed considering whether a suggestion of making The Avenue a one way street from Headley Road to Lark Rise. This may reduce congestion in the area, particularly at the junctions, at it would enable vehicles for school delivery/collection to be parked down one side. Avenue Close could possibly have access restricted except for residents at these times. Members discussed this suggestion and agreed to request HCC to consider.

**Decision:** Asst Clerk to write to Safe Routes to Schools officer to request investigation into this suggestion.

#### **50/05 TO CONSIDER NEW FUNDING FOR COUNTRYSIDE ACCESS IMPROVEMENTS SCHEME**

The Chairman explained the countryside access grant was for a 50/50 matched funding scheme, subject to a maximum grant of £500. Members discussed suggestions for information/interpretation boards for Radford Park and village walks booklets. Members unanimously agreed to proceed with an application to be submitted by 13.1.06 for a grant for a walks leaflet.

**Decision:** The Chairman to set up working party to select walks and submit application for grant by due date.

#### **51/05 REPORT ON WORKS TO BOAT 44**

Asst Clerk confirmed tree and resurfacing works to this right of way have been carried out as part of the capital bid projects by Hampshire County Council. These improvements to the right of way also form part of the cyclerooute around Liphook.

**52/05 TO CONSIDER THE DRAFT BUDGET AND ANY AMENDMENTS FOR 2006/7**

The Chairman referred to the suggestion to re-assign £1,000 from the Passfield Bridleway to Community Transport. Members discussed the work that is required for the section from Waterside Drive to Burgh Hill Road and the works that may be needed to move access to a safer point in Burgh Hill Road. Cllr Coyte proposed leaving the proposed budget for the bridleway in place, until the work was completed and then transferring any surplus. Other budget items were further discussed and agreed.

**Decision:** 4144 - To remain at £1,000 for 2006/7 until works completed, then transfer Surplus to 4261  
4120 – Add £500 for Countryside Access Improvement Scheme grant application for walks leaflet

**53/05 EXCLUSION OF MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC AND PRESS**
