14/12 MINUTES OF MEETING – 23rd January 2012

15/12 MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES

Parking in the Avenue – It was reported that a further meeting had been held to move things along. Cllr Tough objected to not being included in this meeting. Cllr Evans advised that the points that Cllr Tough had raised were all carefully considered at the meeting. It was reported by Cllr Tough that he will be sketching out the safer routes to school and the location of satellite car parking areas.

16/12 DECLARATIONS OF INTERESTS

The Chairman read out the statement. Cllr Tough expressed an interest in The Avenue travel issues as he had been involved in the matter for some years.

It was reported by the member of public present that there had been some hedge trimming in the area and as a result there appeared to be a lot of litter lying round. This was partly due to the litter already there being newly exposed and it was suggested that cutting and clearing should be done at the same time. There was a particular problem on the south exit onto the A3 towards Petersfield. It was agreed that the clerk would write a letter to the County Council concerning this problem and Cllr Moulard would contact Cllr Cowper.

It was further reported that a retrospective planning application was currently being consider by EHDC concerning a gypsy site. It was suggested that Google Earth should be used to provide evidence of whether the site had been established for some time or not. Cllr Moulard agreed to check the current position on the application with EHDC. It was also felt that this issue should be considered by the Planning Committee.

18/12 TO DEVELOP PROJECTS TO INCLUDE IN THE HAMPSHIRE CC BUDGET 2012/13

Contributions from SW trains and from Hampshire CC would be important in completing this project. The clerk agreed to write to Hampshire CC seeking inclusion of this project in the draft programme.
