Cllr Ms Poole advised that this would be an Anglia Windows purpose-built conservatory. The design had been modified after discussion with the neighbour, so that there were no windows in the rear. The neighbour had no objections & was intending to have a similar conservatory.

Decision: No objections provided no windows overlooking the adjacent property, 10 Copperwood Close.

56074 **Single-storey rear extension, following demolition of existing** **Ms James**
Cllr M Croucher **single-storey rear extension - Sonnen-Heim, Devils Lane,**
Liphook

Cllr Croucher stated that this was the last property on the right-hand side before the railway bridge. He had spoken to the neighbour who had invited him into their rear garden to view the house, which was run-down & in poor condition. It had an unused lean-to & a coal shed, & the proposal was to demolish them & replace them with a single-storey living/drawing room, which would be 3m shorter than the current buildings. It would have a ridged roof & the neighbour had some concerns about loss of light but Cllr Croucher did not think that would be the case, & the neighbour did not object to the proposals.

Decision: No objections.
