NEIGHBOURHOOD DEVELOPMENT PLAN

212/17.1: Members agreed to accept the recommendation of the Liaison working group to appoint 7 residents to the NDP working parties and Raine Ryland to the Steering group. It was noted that more volunteers are needed from a wider age and gender demographic.

Proposed by Cllr Ives, Seconded by Cllr Winfield, all in favour.

212/17.2: Members agreed that the NDP Steering Group membership should be increased from 10 to 12 members and that the Terms of Reference should be amended accordingly.

Proposed by Cllr Taplin, Seconded by Cllr Kirby, all in favour.

212/17.3: Members endorsed the completed NDP Interim Report from FERIA Urbanism, having been advised of the changes from the Draft Report approved by Council on the 7th March 2018. Cllr Garnett expressed reservation concerning the lack of documented evidence for the conclusions and was advised that this had been collected at the Forums, documented and filed separately from the main report, because of the bulk of evidence.

Proposed by Cllr Ives, Seconded by Cllr Croucher, all in favour with the exception of Cllr Garnett, who voted against, due to her perception that there was a lack of evidence based conclusions in the report.
