

## **Liphook Conservation Area Character Appraisal and Management Plan Consultation Response**

In response to the draft Conservation Area Character Appraisal and Management Plan document, Bramshott and Liphook Parish Council comments as follows:

In addition to the proposed boundary changes, the following should be included within the Conservation Area:

- All the houses on the right of Headley Road between the proposed Conservation Area boundaries, i.e. to include Nos. 6 to 30, as these Edwardian buildings have character and add to the street scene and the setting of the surrounding conservation area;
- Shipley Court as these buildings have character for the period in which they were built;
- The wall along the right of Portsmouth Road forming the boundary to Shipley Court due to its age and addition to the streetscape.

The following should be included in the guidance:

- A restriction in the amount of advertising signs, posters and street signs within the Conservation Area;
- Any replaced or newly installed bus stops or street furniture, in particular the bus stop outside the Royal Anchor, should be in keeping with the character of the Conservation Area.
