**Report to Parish Council on Neighbourhood Development Plan (NDP)
April 2021**

- **Current position:**

- AECOM have issued the addendum Site Options Assessment report for the additional site. Comments on the draft have been prepared so that AECOM can revise and issue the final report.
- The Housing Needs Assessment technical report has been received and comments on the draft have been prepared so that AECOM can update the report. This draft report is currently being used to help with the assessment of the potential site options that have emerged from the matrix.
- The Steering Group and Working Parties are continuing their liaison with AECOM regarding the 'Evidence Base and Policies Development' assessment. This has had the added benefit of assisting the NDP in further consolidating the proposed policies and reducing overlaps so that each policy is specific and reflective of the needs of the parish. The draft report is expected towards the mid/end of May.
- The Working Party are also assessing which sites have potential to provide facilities and development to suit the community's requirements in order to compile different options for consideration.

- **Next steps:**

- The NDP are working on the land use site options and formulating a series of options of different land uses to put forward to the community for comment as part of a public consultation, and also working with AECOM to update and further strengthen the draft NDP policies.
- Further additional technical packages from Locality are being considered, and whether these can help the NDP with the next stages to help push the plan through to the final section.

- **NDP Members:**

- SG currently has 6 members, which includes the 2 Parish Councillors and new member, Dennis Smith.
- The SG have had a good response to the recent recruitment drive with a further 3 applicants to interview.
- The SG will continue to assess applications following the interview protocols to ensure potential members have an existing positive involvement and engagement with the community and facilities of the Parish.

- **Meeting minutes:**

- Meeting minutes from normal SG meetings are released on our website and social media following approval at SG meetings (not including exempt minutes), and circulated to Parish Councillors, including the exempt meeting minutes, for PC acceptance.
