**Operation Resilience - EH842 – Headley Road Liphook - Carriageway
Resurfacing – Remedial Works**

Further to our previous correspondence regarding the carriageway resurfacing works on a section of Headley Road, Liphook, across its junction with Tunbridge Lane, this letter is to advise that following an inspection of the finished works, some defects have been identified that should not be associated with normal wear and tear. As such, the delivery team have taken the decision to undertake substantial remedial works which will involve the full resurfacing of the defective area.

Whilst the remedial works will progress regardless, an investigation will continue into identifying the exact cause of the defects which will confirm where the full costs for the rectification will be attributed.

The works are programmed to start on Friday 23rd July 2021 and are expected to last for 1 day. During this time, the B3004 and Tunbridge Lane will be closed to vehicular traffic from approximately 07:30 – 18:00 hrs each day. The road will be open outside of these hours

There will be controlled access for residents from the junctions of Hollywater Road, Hunters Chase, or Church Lane (For Tunbridge Lane residents).

Whilst there is an allowance within the time period shown above for delays, there may be times when we have to postpone works at very short notice; based on the latest weather forecasts, this can occur just prior to works commencing.

We will always look to provide up to date information wherever we can, but sometimes these last minute decisions can be difficult to relay to the travelling public in a timely manner. **When we can, any significant changes to the scheduled dates will be made clear on the yellow sign boards located at the works limits.**

In order to help us to complete the work as quickly as possible, please ensure that no vehicles are parked on the road. **Please be aware any vehicles left parked on the road that prevent the works taking place, face the risk of being removed.**

For your safety and that of our workforce, if you are located within the works area we are unable to guarantee vehicular access to and from your property during working hours. Should you need to make an essential journey, please contact a member of the workforce in advance and they will be able to advise if they can accommodate your request. Pedestrian access will be available at all times.

The surfacing operation uses a separate bitumen layer in addition to the new asphalt carriageway surface. In order to avoid potential injury or damage, please do not walk across the carriageway during the works unless directed by a member of the workforce.
