7. RADFORD PARK MANAGEMENT PLAN WORKING PARTY

To receive an update from the working party.

8. GROUNDS MANAGER'S REPORT

To receive an update from the Grounds Manager on the work undertaken by the grounds team and future planned work. **(Appendix 2)**

9. FOOTBALL CLUB

To consider and approve requests from Liphook Football Club.

- (i) To permanently fix the dugouts into position by way of a concrete base or other agreed method.
- (ii) To move the dugouts to the opposite side of the pitch to give them protection from the elements.
- (iii) Should the club purchase moveable goals, could they securely store them in an area by the Grounds Facilities.
- (iv) Can the club use portable floodlights.

10. WM RECREATION GROUND BUILDINGS

To receive an update on progress with the project.

11. FOOTPATH BETWEEN THE LITTLE REC AND WM RECREATION GROUND

To note that a contractor has been appointed to replace the surface with tarmac.

12. PLAY PARK FENCING

To consider whether to replace the existing wooden fence with bow top railings or V mesh panels. Cost approximately £7000 - £13,000 depending on option selected. A request to fund this from CIL Neighbourhood Portion would need to go to full council.

13. RADFORD PARK CAR PARK

To consider whether to seek funding from the council for two projects

- (i) Clean out drains and pipework. Renew pipe from back of kerb to allow drainage of surface water to ditch. Cost approximately £3,200.
- (ii) Install drop kerbs. Supply and lay yellow hatching in front of the new drop kerb. Cost approximately £1,600

14. COMPOUND AT RADFORD PARK

To consider a project to update the compound area.

- (i) Remove all the rubbish in the compound and prepare the area for hard standing. Estimated cost approximately £2,700
- (ii) Supply and install approximately 160mm Hardcore base hard standing to area, machine laid and vibrating roller to compact. Estimated cost approximately £ 2,800.

To consider the future of the skate park, cycle rack and basketball hoop and make a recommendation to full council. (Deferred from the last meeting)
